gray, black or white of any Neumann Sports team. This picture will only be taken once if you miss it you will not be in the picture. See Coach Ahrens if you have any questions.

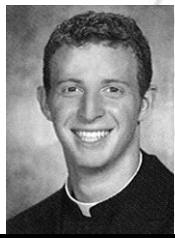
