

## **RESOURCE PROGRAM**

The Resource Room gives help to students who have a learning disability. To qualify for help a test is given by a psychologist. This testing provides two scores, one in achievement and one in intelligence. A learning disabled student will have an average intelligence in the range of 85 to 115. To qualify for resource assistance, a student would have to have an achievement score 20 points lower than the intelligence score.

After the student qualifies, they are eligible for help in the resource room. Students may be referred for testing by teachers or parents. Students qualifying for resource may be in grades 7 through 12.
