### Wahoo Life Chain

The Wahoo Life Chain will be held on Oct. 4<sup>th</sup> from 2-3 P.M. at Twelfth and Beech. For those of you who may not be familiar with this event, "Life Chain is a peaceful and prayerful public witness of pro-life Americans standing for one hour praying for our nation and for an end to abortion. It is a visual statement of solidarity by the Christian community that abortion kills children and that the Church supports the sanctity of human life from the moment of conception."
